**Collecting for either: Self, Self plus other, Other, Partner, Service.**

Give one of everything, for e.g. – 10 syringes + 10 needles = 10 pots + 10 waters + 10 citric or Vit C + 10 wipes.

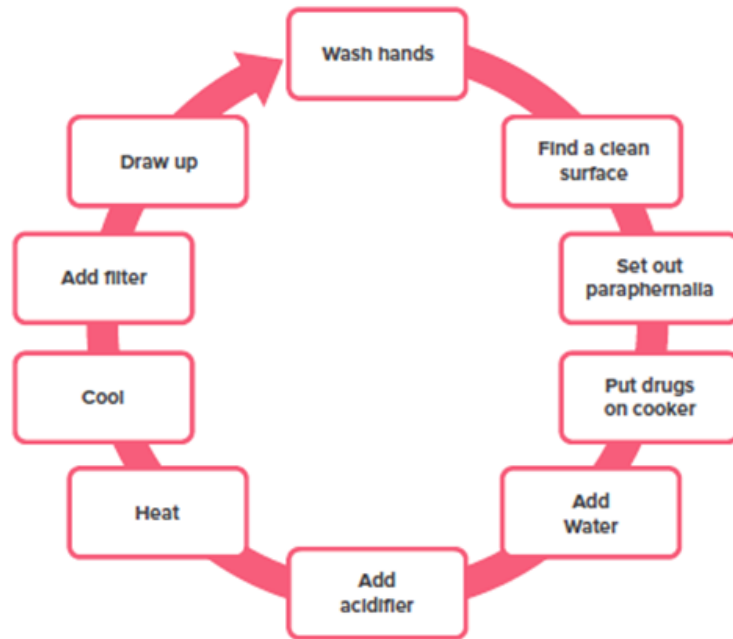
Extra needle heads should be encouraged in case of missed hits. Check how many times daily injecting, ensure enough IEP given.

Foil & Bins should always be offered and encouraged. When detailing no. of Bins also note = L or S (Large or small) Foil = S or R (sheet or roll).

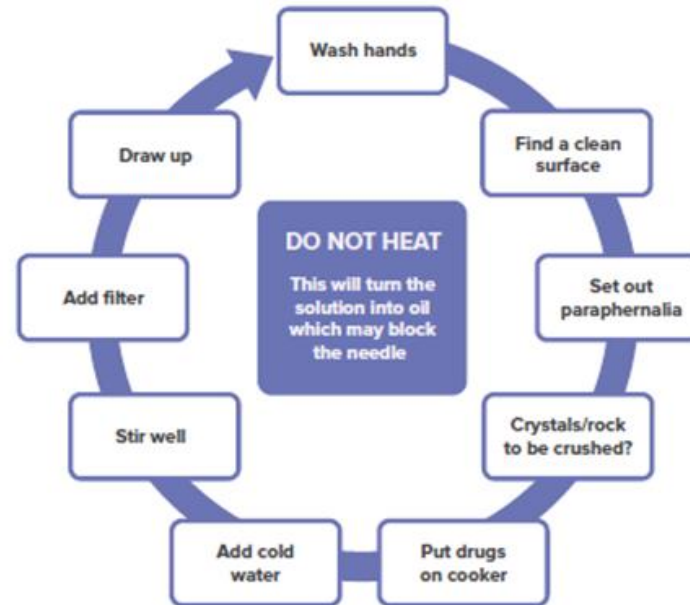
**If the individual has no naloxone, staff must ensure a kit is given.**

Blues = groin. Oranges = legs. Greys = hands/feet. 1ml fixed = arms. Greens only for IPEDs (image/performance enhancing drugs i.e. steroids)

For IPEDs – Green needles should only be used to ‘draw up’ oil based steroids and should not be used to inject. IPEDs are IM (intra muscular) – long or short blue for glutes (buttocks) or deltoids (shoulder) with 2ml syringes and wipes. For sub-cut (stomach) use 1ml fixed with wipes.
